Reporting to the Sports, Arts and Play Development Manager, you will be responsible for supporting Worcester City Council's Sport, Art & Play Development Strategy, whilst identifying creative ways to seek funding to enable the team to continue to deliver a range of sporting opportunities in the future.

The role will assist various initiatives, specifically including the coordination of Worcester City's: Sportivate programmes, School sport development, community multi-sport programmes, football development, marketing and club developments.

It is essential that the successful candidate has a degree in Sports related studies and relevant experience, along with a sound understanding of Sport, Art & Play initiatives and a UKCC Level 2 coaching qualification.
